

The Great Expedition

The great Expedition
is a wacky adventure, full of surprises,
suspense and emotions for young and old.

It's after a long and dangerous journey across the world
that Edouard Lavase, accompanied by his motley menagerie, arrives in your town.

But who is he?

Edourad Lavase, renowned cryptozoologist,
having worked with Professor Bernard Heuvelmanns (Doctor of science in Lausanne).

He is always on the look out for legendary animals,
which may or may not exist, that are only believed to be real thanks
to testimonies collected during his investigations.

He never travels without being accompanied by a herd of geese
and two Swiss Dragons discovered about thirty years ago
in the canton of Lausanne.

After having captured in Bangkok
a species belonging to the “Quetzalcoat” family,
more commonly known as «feathered snake».

(This snake is said to have lost it's Quetzal feathers due to global warming)
and having discovered a gigantic Egg of unknown origins,
the expedition makes a stop in your town.

Fixed show with an introductory parade, duration: 45 minutes,
nighttime performance, suitable for all audiences, capacity: 5,000 people,
team of 22 Plasticiens Volants + 11 local collaborators.

regaining its freedom.






E douard Lavase

The Triton




We can here cracklings.
